



Business Overview and Activities of Scarnose International Limited

The Company is incorporated to carry on a wide range of business activities in India and abroad. The principal business activities of the Company are as follows:

1. Agriculture, Horticulture, and Allied Activities

- The Company shall engage in the planning, cultivation, growing, processing, storing, cleaning, mixing, grading, polishing, canning, importing, exporting, buying, selling, and warehousing of all types of seeds, grains, vegetables, fruits, cereals, herbs, flowers, and other edible and non-edible agricultural products.
- The Company may act in various capacities including, but not limited to, as agents, brokers, stockists, indenters, consignors, merchants, farmers, orchardists, grazers, nurserymen, seed breeders, horticulturists, floriculturists, tissue culturists, timber growers, forest owners, and more.
- The Company shall be involved in all activities related to the farming, cultivation, and production of both commercial and non-commercial crops, including the acquisition, leasing, and licensing of private or government land necessary for carrying out the business operations.

2. Merchandising, Trading, and Manufacturing Activities

- The Company shall engage in the business of importing, exporting, buying, selling, distributing, servicing, contracting, and dealing with goods, merchandise, machinery, and equipment across a broad spectrum of industries.
- This includes, but is not limited to, the following categories:
 - **Agricultural products:** Including herbal, organic products, vanaspati, tobacco products, food and dairy products, cereals, and beverages.
 - **Industrial goods and machinery:** Including textiles (yarn, jute, wool, silk, garments), construction materials, glass products, synthetics, electrical and electronics, automobiles, auto ancillaries, tyres, chemicals, petrochemicals, polymers, oil and lubricants, and more.
 - **Consumer goods:** Personal care products, cosmetics, pharmaceuticals, soaps, detergents, and other household goods.
 - **Precious goods and metals:** Including jewellery, diamonds, precious and semi-precious stones, metals (gold, silver, copper, zinc), coke, steels, aluminium, ferro alloys, and related products.



- **Building and infrastructure materials:** Cement, paper, paints, varnishes, plastics, rubber products, etc.
- **Technology and electronics:** Including data processing systems, software, computers, electronics, and other technological goods.
- **Other merchandise:** Livestock, books, abrasives, air-conditioners, refrigerators, pumps, machinery, industrial tools, medical equipment, fire protection systems, pollution control equipment, and more.
- The Company will also engage in assembling, erecting, installing, distributing, repairing, maintaining, and selling on a hire-purchase or installment system for all the above-mentioned goods and equipment.

3. Pharmaceutical, Healthcare, and Wellness Products

- The Company shall carry on business as manufacturers, traders, marketers, and distributors of bulk drugs (APIs), pharmaceuticals, and medical formulations, including the following:
 - **Generic APIs:** Including but not limited to oncology drugs, beta-lactam antibiotics, cephalosporins, and vaccines.
 - **Finished pharmaceutical formulations:** Solid dosage forms like tablets, capsules, dry powder, syrups, and liquid forms such as IV preparations, ampoules, vials, eye drops, and semi-solid forms like creams, ointments, gels, and emulsions.
 - **Personal hygiene and wellness products:** Sanitary pads, diapers, women hygiene products, nutraceuticals, baby care products, disinfectants, sanitizing products, deodorizing products, and cleaning products.
 - **Agricultural and animal care products:** Fertilizers, agrochemicals, and other agricultural farming products related to pharmaceutical applications.

4. E-commerce, Direct Selling, and Marketing

- The Company shall also engage in direct selling, brand establishment, and e-commerce-based sales, marketing, and distribution of the products mentioned above.
- This includes the operation of online platforms for the sale of products such as pharmaceutical items, agricultural goods, personal care products, and household goods.



- The Company will establish and maintain a robust online presence to facilitate the sale and distribution of goods through various e-commerce channels.

5. Additional Business Activities

- The Company may also engage in any other business activity related to the above-mentioned areas as may be necessary or incidental to the attainment of the objectives of the Company. This may include ancillary services such as warehousing, logistics, clearing and forwarding, and other related business functions.
